#### Monday- September 27- Elderly Day

#### Tuesday- September 28 - Super Hero or Villain Day

Good guy or bad guy? The choice is up to you! You can wear your favorite superhero/villain T-Shirt with jeans...you can even go all out by adding the cape.

#### Wednesday- September 29- Decades Day

Dress as someone who lived during your favorite decade. Think Poodle Skirts in the 50's, Hippie in the 60's, Flower Child in the 70's, Punk Rock in the 80's...the options are limitless!

#### Thursday- September 30- Royalty Day (Formal Wear Day)

On this day we will have our Queen's Court Luncheon during lunch time.

Girls...no strapless/sleeveless/tank/off-the-shoulder/cold shoulder/halter/spaghetti strap/tight form-fitting dresses. (If you want to wear a dress without sleeves you may wear a jacket or cardigan but it must be worn ALL day). - Absolutely NO sweat pants, track pants, yoga pants, bodysuits, or tights! !
